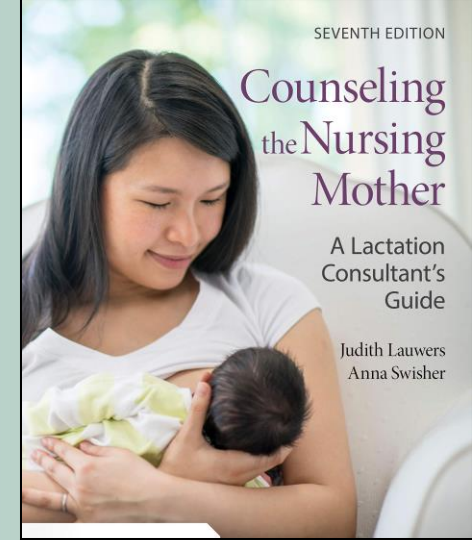
Human milk...for all newborns



- Benefits of breastfeeding are well known
- Human milk feeding – right of every newborn
- Availability of CLMC – helps bridge the gap
- Volume of milk available in the CLMC freezer - Rate limiting step for provision of human milk to all neonates

Increase collection

- Strengthen counselling services
- Reach out to more lactating mothers – Greater advocacy
- Create more collection areas
- Use better quality pumps, maintain them well
- Ensure steady supply of lactasets
- Encourage hand expression for donation
- Innovative solutions: Milk donation camp, satellite centres, longitudinal donations



Optimise utilisation

- Clear protocol for who will receive PDHM
- Emphasize on availability MOM
- Counsel families for reduction in dependence on PDHM
- Innovative solutions: transport MOM from mother to baby

Reduce wastage

- Quality improvement in processes
- Reduce scope for contamination
- Appropriate handling of PDHM
- Smaller aliquots for storage
